## Hygiene and Protective Measures

The Bavarian Infection Protection Measures Ordinance against the spread of the corona virus will set for the TAC-5 2022 conference the standard under which conditions the event can be planned and carried out in Bad Aibling, Bavaria, Germany.

In addition, protection and hygiene measures laid down by the DLR organiser and the Hotel St. Georg must be observed by all participants of the TAC-5 2022 conference in order to protect the health of our staff and participants.

Participation in the TAC-5 2022 conference is only possible with a **valid 2G certificate** (Vaccinated, Recovered). The organizer will document the contact data of the TAC -5 2022 participants.

The following proofs are accepted:

- Digital or written proof of the protective vaccination carried out in the national language and in English, if the last required vaccination was carried out 14 days previously and one of the vaccines or vaccine combination approved within the EU and published by the Paul Ehrlich Institute was used.

- Digital or written proof of convalescence in the national language and in English (positive PCR test), which is at least 28 days old and at most six months old.

Digital proof (CORONA WARN app, digital vaccination certificate) is preferred. For expedited entry, enter your proof of vaccination into the CORONA WARN app.

The following measures apply to the TAC-5 2022 conference and will be adjusted if necessary in accordance with official requirements.

You will certainly be curious about the measures we have taken to protect your health and data. We have compiled the most important aspects for you here.

To minimise the risk of infection with COVID-19, we also need your help. Therefore, in the second section you will find an overview of the officially prescribed rules of conduct that all guests, as well as the organization team, must follow.

## **SAFETY & HYGIENE MEASURES**

Participation in the event TAC-5 2022 is only possible with a 2 G status. Participants must prove at the that they have either recovered or have been vaccinated ("2-Rule) to have access to the conference

All participants must comply with the Corona Hygiene and Protection rules of the DLR organizer and those set up by he Hotel St. Georg.

All contact surfaces in the conference aera , such as door handles or tables, are disinfected regularly on a daily basis. Special attention is paid also to the disinfection of catering areas and s sanitary rooms. On site, there is continuous monitoring of the rules of cleaning and conduct.



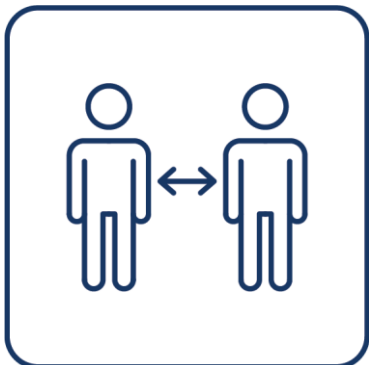
## **FACE MASK PROTECTION**

A face mask that covers your mouth and nose must be worn in all public areas of the hotel and also in the conference rooms

For the TAC-5 2022 even with 2 G status, masks are obligatory in all conference rooms.

If you have forgotten your own face mask, a replacement will be waiting for you at check-in.

All staff on site are also instructed to wear face masks.



## **DISTANCING**

We ensure the safety of all participants, by actively limiting the number of attendees of the TAC- 5 conference.

Additionally, the general traffic areas will be laid out in such a way that social distancing rules can be upheld without any problems.

## **FOOD AND DRINK**

All catering services at Hotel St. Georg are offered in compliance with corona hygiene and protection measures.

## **PARTICIPANT MANAGEMENT onsite:**

- Limitation of the number of guests
- At the entrance check of 2 G status of the participants
- Recording of attendance and departure times
- Each guest has to fill out a contact form with a questionnaire about his or her state of health. The questionnaire complies with the current data protection regulations.
- After the conference - Documentation of the event.

## **WHAT RULES DO I HAVE TO FOLLOW AS A PARTICIPANT OF THE TAC-5 2022:**

- Carry your own mouth-nose protective mask and use your mouth-nose protective mask.
- The mouth and nose protector must be worn if several people are present in a room for a long period of time, even if minimum distances are guaranteed.
- Also wear your mask in all designated places (e.g. in the sanitary facilities)
- Obey the known distance rules and ground markings
- Wash your hands regularly and thoroughly
- No shaking hands and no hugs
- Sneeze into the crook of your arm, avoid facing anyone or anything.
- Dispose of personal waste yourself.

**Only those who accept the protection and hygiene regulations are entitled to join the TAC-5 2022 conference on site.**

## **WHAT HAPPENS IF THERE IS A SUDDEN CASE OF ILLNESS?**

In the unlikely event of a recognisable suspected infection of a person with COVID-19, there is a tested action plan:

- The person is sent directly home.
- In case of an emergency (if not able to act/drive, etc.), an ambulance is called and the person is isolated until then.
