



Information in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the German Data Protection Act (Bundesdatenschutzgesetz) with regard to the processing of image/sound/video recordings:

1. Purpose of data processing

The processing of the image, sound or video recordings and the other personal data (name of contributor as contained in the conference contribution) is carried out for the purpose of publishing the image, sound or video recordings and for the purpose of posting your conference contribution on the website as explained above.

2. Storage duration

The data will be deleted as soon as they are no longer necessary for the purpose for which they were collected. This is the conference website on which the conference contribution and the video and audio recordings of the oral presentation are posted on the conditions you gave us your consent to do so. If you withdraw your consent we will delete the data of the recording and the conference contribution on the website and on our servers and computer systems.



4. We process your data on the basis of Art. 6 (1) (a) (consent), Art. 6 (1) (b) (contract) and Art. 6 (1) (f) (legitimate interests) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

We process your personal data from the image/sound/video recordings and conference contribution in accordance with Art. 6 (1) (a) on the basis of your consent and in accordance with Art. 6 (1) (b) on the basis of the license agreement concluded with you and in accordance with Art. 6 (1) (f) of the DSGVO in order to safeguard our legitimate interests, to inform the public about the event, to document the event and to be able to defend the copyrights for the duration of the copyright protection of the recordings.

5. Are data transferred to a third country?

The data as indicated above will be published on the Internet and therefore is accessible from all over the world.

6. Your rights as a data subject in relation to your personal data

According to the GDPR, a **data subject** is any person whose personal **data** is being collected, held or processed.

You have the following rights in relation to the controller in accordance with the provisions specified below:

- (1) Pursuant to Art. 15 of the GDPR, you can request **information** about the personal data processed by us. In particular, you can request information about the purposes of the processing, the category of the personal data, the categories of recipients to whom your personal information has been or will be disclosed, the intended storage period and the existence of the rights explained in sections 4 and 6 of this document.
- (2) Pursuant to Art. 16 of the GDPR, you can request the immediate **rectification** of incorrect personal data or the completion of incomplete personal data stored by us.
- (3) Pursuant to Art. 17 of the GDPR, you can request the **erasure** of your personal data stored by us, unless the processing is necessary for legal reasons, in particular to exercise the right to freedom of expression and information, to fulfil a legal obligation, for reasons of public interest, to assert or exercise legal claims or for the potential defence of such legal claims.
- (4) Pursuant to Art. 18 of the GDPR, you shall have the right to obtain from the controller **restriction of processing** if you contest the accuracy of these data and assert that the processing is unlawful. This would apply if you have opposed the erasure of the personal data and we no longer require the data, but you need the data for the assertion, exercise or defence of legal claims or if you have filed an objection to the data processing in accordance with Art. 21 of the GDPR.
- (5) Pursuant to Art. 20 of the GDPR, you have the right to receive the personal data provided to the controller in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and have the right to **transmit** those data to another controller.
- (6) Pursuant to Art. 7 (3) of the GDPR, you have the right to **withdraw** the consent you previously granted to us at any time. As a result, we will no longer be permitted to continue the data processing that was based on this consent.
- (7) Pursuant to Art. 21 of the GDPR – the right to object

If your personal data is processed on the basis of legitimate interests pursuant to Art. 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR, you have the right to object to the processing of that personal data in accordance with Art. 21 of the GDPR, provided that there are reasons for this related to your particular situation or if you are objecting to direct marketing. In the latter case, you have a general right of objection, which will be implemented by us without specifying any particular situation, unless the processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out for reasons of public interest (as per Art. 21 (6) of the GDPR).

- (8) Pursuant to Art. 77 of the GDPR, you have the right to lodge a **complaint** with a supervisory authority. In general, the supervisory authority located at your usual place of residence or workplace or the registered address of the controller is available for this purpose. In order to exercise these rights, please contact the office indicated in No. 3 above.
